



WEDNESDAY NIGHT LEAGUE

Teams – Teams of 5. Teams can be made up of any combination of men and women and handicaps, though everyone must be a golf member.

Format – Each week teams will nominate 2 golfers to compete. Each golfer on your team must play an equal number of 9-hole rounds during the season (e.g., if a team plays all 20 weeks, each of the 5 golfers must play 8 9-hole rounds). Tee times are 3-5pm on Wednesday evenings. Scorecards can be picked up in the pro shop anytime from 3-5pm on Wednesdays, then returned to the pro shop after play. We'll provide a box outside the pro shop (near the 19th Hole) where scorecards can be dropped if the shop is closed when you finish.

League Play – 20 weeks, 4/26 through 9/6. A team's total score will be the sum of their top 30 individual scores over the 20 weeks. Teams do not have to play in all 20 weeks, but they'll still need to count their 30 best scores. From there the top 6 teams qualify for the playoffs.

Scoring – For the league portion we'll be using Stableford scoring, with 50% of your handicap. Scorecards will be printed out the day of the event for those who are playing that day, with dots marked on holes where golfers have shots. Golfers are responsible for their own scorecard; once a scorecard is handed in, it is final and cannot be changed after the fact. Double bogey max, and points are:

- Albatross – 5 points (6 with a shot, instead of with a putt)
- Eagle – 4 points (5 with a shot)
- Birdie – 3 points (4 with a shot)
- Par – 2 points (3 with a shot)
- Bogey – 1 point (2 with a shot)
- Double bogey – 0 points (1 with a shot)

Tees – Women (Red/Green or Green Tees). Senior Men 50+ (Gold Tees). Men under 50 (White Tees). Men Under 40 (Blue Tees).

Playoffs – Playoff matches will also be held on Wednesday evenings. These matches will be at 50% handicap match play instead of Stableford. Match play will be 9 holes. A match victory is worth 1 point with a half point awarded for a draw—no playoffs to settle matches. A final playoff will be held if 2 teams are still tied after all matches are completed: 10th tee box down to the 18th hole – closest to the pin wins.

- Teams seeded 1 & 2 get byes into the semifinal. Team 3 plays team 6 and team 4 plays team 5.
- The semifinals will be team 1 vs. the winners of 4 vs. 5 and team 2 vs. the winners of 3 vs. 6.
- From here we will have the grand final which will be 9 holes of match play between the 2 finalists.
